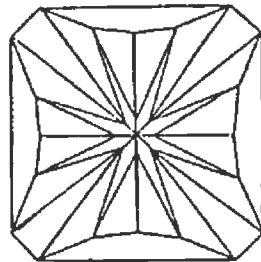


Fig. 2 Barion Square split-faceted

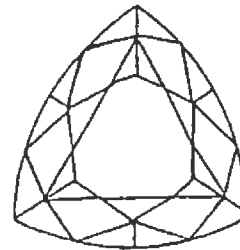


Fig. 5 Trilliant C Crown

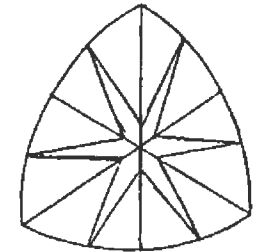


Fig. 6 Trilliant C Pavilion

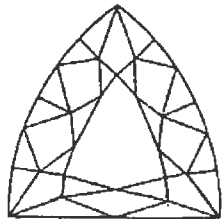


Fig. 3 Seminavette Crown

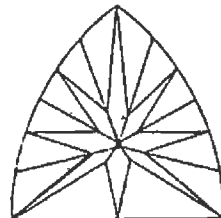


Fig. 4 Seminavette Pavilion

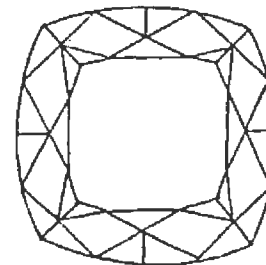


Fig. 7 Square Cushion Crown

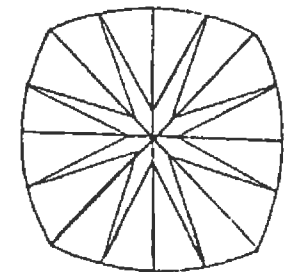


Fig. 8 Square Cushion Base
